

TECH INSPECTION

In order to minimize non-driving activities at the track, your car must be inspected prior to the school. The options are as follows:

- 1) Take your car to a qualified mechanic for tech inspection and checklist sign-off **AND STAMPED.**
- 2) If you are your own mechanic, CALL ME to discuss. These exceptions will be very limited.

ENGINE COMPARTMENT/DRIVELINE

___ Fan belts OK, tight, no cracks

___ Engine mounts solid

___ Throttle linkage OK

___ Driveshaft components and bearings OK

___ Header and exhaust OK

___ *Hoses secure & flexible, no cracks/rubbing*

___ Battery secure, lugs tight

___ Two throttle return springs

___ Fluid levels OK (incl trans and diff), no leaks

___ Brake fluid full and fresh

TIRES/SUSPENSION

___ Minimum 5/32" tread, even wear

___ Springs and shocks OK

___ Front strut mounting locations & hardware OK

___ Brake heat performance - check for brake fade and rotor warpage with 3 or 4 hard stops from 60mph.

___ Wheel bearings, ball joints tight

___ Brake pads and shoes OK

___ Rear unibody subframe & differential mountings OK

INTERIOR

___ Steering wheel play OK

___ Fire extinguisher mounted in car (optional, but encouraged)

___ Pedal check OK

___ Driver seat & belt in good working order

___ *Passenger seat & belt design & condition, equal to or better than driver seat & belt*
